

## August 2021

- a) The queries raised by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) on the Initial Self Evaluation Report submitted seeking their accreditation were discussed and answers for submitted to the Board of Management (BOM) of the PIM.
- b) Training workshop on Sri Lanka Qualification Framework (SLQF) was held
- c) Programme learning outcomes of MBA and MPA programmes were revised to be in par with the expected attributes of Level 10 qualification holders stated in the SLQF.
- d) Compiling the documents useful for programme management was started and is being continued.
- e) Following policies were developed:
  - Plagiarism Policy
  - Library Policy
- f) Format for submitting the revisions of curricula of existing degree programmes was prepared.
- g) Format to map the programme learning outcomes of the MBA and MPA programmes with the expected attributes of the qualification holders of SLQF Level 10 were developed.
- h) Format to map the intended learning outcomes of courses with the nationally important learning outcomes stipulated in the SLQF was developed.
- i) Format to map the intended learning outcomes of courses with the five pillars of PIM stated in its mission was developed.
- j) Second meeting of the Centre for Quality Assurance and Accreditation was held, and the activities carried out were reported at the faculty meeting.
- k) The progress of quality assurance activities at the PIM during the month was reported to the Director of the Quality Assurance Centre of the University of Sri Jayewardenepura.
- l) The progress of quality assurance activities during the months g July and August was reported to the BOM of PIM.
